5	 Identify new words from written text using context and previous knowledge as a guide Transcribe and read aloud longer sentences using their knowledge of common sounds Give opinions followed by infinitive verbs with reasons Produces short paragraphs using connectives, intensifiers and time phrases Speak and write in the I, he/she, we and they forms using a range of present tense verbs Confidently use negatives in a sentences Identify and use another tense (I would like)
6	 Transcribe and read aloud unfamiliar vocabulary using their knowledge of common sounds Give opinions followed by infinitive verbs with reasons Produce longer paragraphs using connectives, intensifiers and time phrases Speak and write in the I, he/she, we and they forms using a range of present tense verbs Confidently use negatives when speaking and writing Identify and use other tenses; either past or future
